**Interview Notes**

Donor 4063 is adorable and charming. He came across as earnest, and open to the world of possibility before him. He spoke of his current freshman year at college with enthusiasm, only disappointed that education is not free for everyone. He seems to be a serious student, appreciating the variety of classes and learning opportunities at his finger tips. His appreciation for education, most likely, stems from the influence of his parents; two people that are described as extremely intelligent, humorous and charismatic. He is currently studying Art, Business, and Psychology – the latter of which he is particularly excited about. He feels that at 19, he is of course too young to know what career he will someday choose; he is simply happy to be studying and surrounded by people equally motivated to learn. Ideally he hopes to find a career in music, in which case he would feel as if he was not working at all.

Donor 4063 is profoundly dedicated to his instrument, the guitar. But this does not stop him from also playing the bass, drums, and now teaching himself the piano. He is presently in three bands and plays classical, blues, rock, flamenco, jazz, metal, and alternative music. His mother was a great influence in this area, always playing blues tunes and singing, which he notes as the root of his open-mindedness to many genres of music from a young age. During high school he was playing guitar 6-7 hours a day, and now practices whenever he can – and at least a few hours a day.

Donor 4063 began drawing at the age of three, and was recognized as having above-average coordination for his age. He was also a skateboarder in high school, but recently gave it up after an accident in which he broke his arm and temporarily had to give up the guitar. Referring lightly to drawing and skateboarding alike, this donor is of the general sentiment that anything that threatens his guitar-playing is a waste of time.

Donor 4063 was very cute and easy on the eyes. His skin is clear and of a rich, olive complexion. His hair is thick and has a healthy sheen. He looked fit and thin, sporting a crisp pair of jeans, freshly washed hooded sweatshirt, and well-loved sneakers. His eyes were dark and clear, and he had a warm and comfortable smile.
