## **Donor 3927 Interview Notes**

Donor 3927 is a very grounded and gentle person. During his interview he seemed calm, his posture straight but at ease. He wore casual athletic clothing and a ball cap that covered his thick wavy brown hair. His deep brown eyes and thick eyebrows made him seem more serious than he was. He answered questions with ease in a deep voice and although he didn't smile often, when he did his sweetness was infectious. He struck me as a very honest trustworthy guy.

The donor works in operations management and has a vast interest in mathematics. He was the recipient of a large college scholarship and later received an Outstanding Graduate in Mathematics and Science award. He has a profound interest in solving the Riemann Hypothesis, one of the most famous and important unsolved problems in mathematics. In the future, he envisions himself owning a software company or designing video games.

Athleticism comes very naturally to donor 3927. He routinely visits his gym to do cardio and strength training. As a child he pitched a championship game for his Little League and played as an All Star. He has two Major League Baseball players in his paternal lineage. He is very conscientious about the foods he eats, staying away from hydrogenated oils and high fructose corn syrup, and preferring to buy his meats and vegetables at a local farmers market.

Possibly the most endearing characteristic of donor 3927 is his devotion to family and family life. His goal in life is to 'be the best father and husband on earth'. He values family above all other things and very much looks forward to fathering his own children.

Although the donor was adopted, the adoption was open and he has contact with his biological family. He is in contact via email with his three biological siblings, all of whom are in good health. He makes a conscious effort to maintain that contact because he feels that knowing where you come from is very important. This is one of the reasons he has chosen to become an Identity-Release donor. It seemed to me that this decision came with a lot of thought and integrity.
