Donor # 3970 Interview Notes

At our first meeting, the confidence and maturity exuded by Donor 3970 immediately put me at ease. His thoroughness and attention to detail made the health history review a snap. Rather than spending the majority of the time following up with unanswered questions or filling in the blanks, donor 3970 and I were able to speak casually and have a very wonderful conversation.

After discovering that 3970 was an enthusiastic conversationalist, it came as no surprise to find out that he had a Masters of Arts in Creative Writing. Currently, donor 3970 is teaching creative writing at a collegiate level. He intends to also pursue his personal passion to be a story writer, poet or novelist. At this stage in his career he doesn't have any best-sellers. He has, however, written and illustrated a series of children's stories for his friends and family. The book was written in dedication to his maternal grandmother, whom also was a writer of children's stories.

Despite the fact that his father died when the donor was only four years old, the donor was still able to give sufficient information. His father died of breast cancer at the young age of 34. I inquired about the diagnosis and confirmed that there were no other family members that have been diagnosed with breast cancer.

Also, due to religious beliefs, the donor's maternal grandmother did not seek medical attention and therefore, was not diagnosed with any health conditions until later on in life. After the maternal grandmother's death, the maternal grandfather began to seek medical care, if needed. Currently, no other family member has any restrictions regarding medical care.

Overall I would describe this donor as a gentle, charming guy with a subtle wit. He also put much thought and consideration into his responses, even unconsciously taking on the pose of "The Thinking Man". He has a handsome broad, athletic build and evenly tanned skin and blond hair.
