### FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Allergies: **MA: mild hay fever, manages with over-the-counter medication**

Cancer: **MGM: skin cancer, onset in 60s, removed melanoma, loved the sun**

Gastro-intestinal: **MGM: gallstones, onset in 30s, removed and resolved**

Genital/Reproductive: **MA: endometriosis, onset in early 30s, treated with hysterectomy (a common procedure at the time)**

Heart: **F: high cholesterol onset 57, only slightly elevated; MGF: hardening of arteries and mild heart attack, onset late 80s; MGF: abdominal aneurysm, onset at 91, cause of death at 94; PGF: high blood pressure onset at 18, no treatment necessary; PGF: heart valve replacement surgery, cause of death at 56; MGM: high cholesterol, onset in 70s, manages with medication; MA: high cholesterol, diagnosed late 40s, manages with medication**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **M: hypothyroid disease, onset in 40s, treated successfully with medication; MGM: hypothyroid disease, diagnosed in 60s, managed with medication**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **F: arthritis in spine, onset at 55 due to running, treated with medication; MGM: osteoporosis, onset in 70s, managed with medication; MA: osteoporosis, onset in late 40s, no treatment necessary, most recent bone density test OK**

Neurological: **M: migraines, onset in 20s, treated with over-the-counter medication, not problematic; MGF migraines, onset in 20s**

Respiratory: **PGF: emphysema, onset at 54, was a smoker**

Skin: **M: eczema, onset in 20s, cleared when moved to New England**
