FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Cancer: **PGF: brain cancer onset at 44 and cause of death at age 46**

Heart: **F: high blood pressure and ruptured aorta in his late 30s; GM: high blood pressure and high cholesterol onset in her early 40s, managed with medication**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **MGM: adult onset diabetes onset in late 40s, related to diet and lifestyle**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **MGM: scoliosis diagnosed in her early 40s, but no treatment necessary**

Neurological: **D: shingles at age 19 due to stress; F: migraines, epilepsy onset at age 39**

Respiratory: **MGM: emphysema onset in early 40s due to smoking**

Sight/Sound/Smell: **D and F: color blind; D: slightly nearsighted (R: 20/15, L: 20/50)**

Substance abuse: **F: addiction to prescription drugs onset in 30s; entered treatment at age 40**

Urinary: **MGM: kidney disease (resulting from diabetes) cause of death at age 69**

Other: **Color-blindness is caused by a common X-linked recessive gene and affects about 10% of men. Male offspring conceived using this donor will not inherit color-blindness from the donor.**

Female offspring conceived using this donor will be carriers for color-blindness, which means they have a 50% chance of passing the trait onto their sons.
