Genital/Reproductive: **S1: Endometriosis/Bifurcated Uterus, found at 30, treated with hospital/bed rest during pregnancy, resulted in premature birth of her child.**

Heart: **M: High Blood Pressure, onset in early 40s, managed with medication; MGM: Heart Attack suspected as cause of death at 87; MGF: Heart Attack at 56, continued heart issues ultimately led to death at 60**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **F: Adult-Onset Diabetes, onset at 40, diet related, resolved with diet and exercise; M: Thyroid Disease, onset at 40, thyroid removed with surgery and issue controlled with medication**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **D: Plantar Fasciitis, onset at 27, untreated, fully functional**  
**MGM: Herniated disk, onset in 70s, treated with medication and physical therapy, now has minor back pain**

Neurological: **S1: Migraines, onset at 18, controls with situational medication; MC1: Migraines, onset at 16, treated with medication, now has occasional occurrences**
