### FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Breast Cancer: **M: age of onset, 39, had a mastectomy/chemotherapy, is now 52 and in full remission**

Genital/Reproductive: **MGF: colon cancer, age on onset 48, successfully removed tumor. PGF: prostate cancer, age of onset 62, attempted to remove prostate, cause of death at age 69.**

Heart: **D: pulmonic murmur, diagnosed at age 19 by TSBC's physician, no treatment required and donor leads an active lifestyle. MGF: hardening of the arteries, age of onset 48, has experienced one seizure but has had no lasting damage and has changed his diet since the incident; high blood pressure, age of onset 54, controlled with medication; high cholesterol, age of onset 60, controlled with diet and exercise; heart failure, age of onset 82, cause of death.**

Respiratory: **F: asthma, age of onset 13, used an inhaler until the age of 18, condition resolved in adulthood. MGM: emphysema due to heavy smoking, age of onset age 60, cause of death at age 65.**

Sight/Sound/Smell: **D: R 20/10, L 20/13**

Cancer (see above): **M: breast cancer. MGF: colon cancer. PGF: prostate cancer**
