Blood: **M: mild anemia, no treatment necessary**
Gastro-intestinal: **PGM: hepatitis C cause of death at age 79**
Genital/Reproductive: **M: hysterectomy at age 46 due to uterine fibroids**
Heart: **MGM: heart attack/ventricular aneurysm cause of death at age 77**
Mental Health: **D: periodic panic attacks between ages 8 and 20, resolved by taking anti-depressant for 6 months at age 20; D: mild situational depression at age 23, treating with Celexa (an anti-depressant); M: anxiety prone, panic attacks as a teenager**
Metabolic/Endocrine: **PGF: adult-onset diabetes in his 60s or 70s due to poor diet**
Neurological: **PGF: a series of strokes cause of death at age 81; MGF: dementia onset in early 70s prior to death at age 75**
Respiratory: **D: mild hay fever and allergies to pet dander as a child, asthma between ages 5 and 12; M: hay fever, allergies to cats, mild asthma as an adult**
Sight/Sound/Smell: **D: near-sighted, 20/200 in both eyes**
