FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Genital/Reproductive: **M: hysterectomy at age 50 due to prolapsed uterus; MA#2: hysterectomy at age 53 due to prolapsed uterus; MA#3: hysterectomy at age 42 due to uterine fibroids**

Heart: **M: high cholesterol onset early 50s, treats with diet, exercise, and medication; F: high blood pressure onset in mid 30s, treats with medication; PGM: high blood pressure and high cholesterol, treats with medication**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **M: hyperthyroid onset in her mid 40s, treats with medication; MGM: adult onset diabetes in her late 70s due to diet and lack of exercise, treats with medication**

Neurological: **MCo: mental retardation, possibly Down's syndrome**

Respiratory: **MA#3, PCo: mild asthma**

Sight/Sound/Smell: **D: very nearsighted (20/300 in right eye; 20/375 in left eye)**

Skin: **S, MCo: acne in teenage years, no scarring**

Substance abuse: **F: alcoholism, father does not identify as an alcoholic, but donor and mother think he is, he drinks beer every night, and often drinks alone; MGF: alcoholic most of his adult life, he may be in recovery in his 70s (he has contacted donor's mother in recent years, but donor chooses not to have contact with him)**
