Interview Notes

Donor 3283 struck me as intellectual, reserved and private. The donor seems quite comfortable with abstraction and theory. Majoring in the social sciences, the donor focused on political science and history, but also studied sociology and economics. He speaks both English and Spanish fluently.

Donor 3283 currently tutors elementary school children in vocabulary skills. He is extremely choosy about his words, stating that it can take hours for him to complete an essay. Organization and particularity seem to run in the family. The donor shared that as a young boy he would help out in his grandfather's housewares shop. His grandfather kept a detailed numbering system to organize his products. The donor himself has organized his personal library by subject, and then alphabetically within each subject.

Born in Mexico, the donor moved with his family to Arizona at an early age, and then to California. He spent much of his youth returning to Mexico and visiting relatives. Recently he went back, spending several months tutoring children living in an orphanage. He enjoyed tutoring in Mexico more than in the US because the children expressed more interest in learning.

The donor is very health conscious. He adheres to a vegetarian diet for ethical reasons, practices martial arts, and cycles everywhere. The donor is slender, with thick dark brown hair, light brown eyes, and fair skin.
