FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Blood: **D: anemia probably caused by vegetarian diet. S: anemia probably caused by poor diet.**
Cancer: **S: Hodgkin's disease diagnosed and treated at 28. MGF: Bladder cancer onset at 82, cause of death at 84.**

Genital/Reproductive: **M: premature menopause; MGM: premature menopause. *see note**
Heart: **MGF: high cholesterol, onset at 60, controlled by medication. MGF: high blood pressure, onset at 50 controlled by medication.**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **PGF: mild diabetes- adult onset**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **M, MGM: minor scoliosis**

Neurological: **D,S,M,PA: Migraine Headaches; PGM: stroke at age 80**

Other: **D: received growth hormone treatment at 17**

**Based on available information, we do not know if there is a genetic component to both the donor's mother and maternal grandmother having had premature menopause. According to our genetic counselor, it is conceivable there is there is a genetic component; assuming the highest possible genetic component (a dominate gene) there is at most a 25% chance of the donor's offspring inheriting a predisposition to premature menopause. Given that premature menopause is not a significant health risk, our Medical Director has approved this donor as eligible for donation.*
