## Donor 3455 Interview Notes

Donor 3455 is a sweet young man with a gentle manner. He was a bit shy during our interview, but while he didn't volunteer much information, he answered all my questions thoughtfully. I got the sense that he is very responsible and intelligent. He is clearly very close with his immediate family. His mother is a medical social worker and his father is a psychologist in private practice. He acknowledged that his parents brought a high level of awareness to family dynamics and that he feels he and his siblings benefited from their communication skills and willingness to talk things through. The whole family traveled together frequently during the donor's childhood: to Europe and throughout the US. The donor commented that he especially loved Vancouver and enjoys visiting New York City, where he still has many relatives. He would like to live in New York some day, perhaps for graduate school.

The donor is half way through college and is majoring in Mass Communications. He was drawn to the field because it is such a diverse discipline, combining many different areas of study, such as sociology and psychology. He plans to pursue an MBA in the future, although he's not yet sure what type of business he might like to go into.

Donor 3455 is an attractive young man with gorgeous large brown eyes. He is fit and healthy. He played soccer and baseball as a child and was captain of his high school tennis team.
