Allergies: **D: multiple allergies including grass and mold (reaction sneezing, itching, watery eyes), Amoxicillin and Tetracycline (reaction throat swelling, body rash), Erythromycin and Flexrol (reaction fever, joint swelling)**

Cancer: **F: bone cancer, cause of death at 36, has 4 brothers and no immediate family members with cancer, was in the navy in Vietnam and donor believes that environmental factors played a part**

Gastro-intestinal: **MGM: liver disease/cirrhosis, due to long term use of percocet to manage chronic pain from car accident in her 30s**

Heart: **MGF: heart attack at age 81, cause of death along with falling down the stairs; MU: heart attack, after swimming late 30s or 40s; PGF: heart failure, cause of death at age 77; PGM: heart failure, cause of death at age 98, was still active until then**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **D: neck injury from playing football in high school, fused vertebrae causes arthritic pain in the winter, occasionally used marijuana medicinally for pain**

Sight/Sound/Smell: **D: nearsighted and astigmatism, right eye: 20/25, left eye: 20/25**
