I'm very respectful of others and make a conscious effort not to fit the offensive "stereotypes" that Black men are labeled with. Although I'm extroverted, I've always been somewhat shy. Throughout school I was considered the nice guy that everyone gets along with. I'm very passionate about the people I love. I'm honest and try to always do what's right. I like to be comfortable and I don't like taking risks unless it's connected to the things I'm very passionate about and is necessary. Although my wife likes taking risks and has convinced me to do things I wouldn't choose to do myself. Most of my life has been fairly easy and I don't enjoy or appreciate hardship. I usually have good luck and good fortune. I'm moody when I don't eat. Most consider me a physically handsome guy with a beautiful wife and a very handsome son. I've always been mature for my age ... got into a relationship with my wife at the age of 18 and got married at the age of 23. She's eight years older than me.**

What are your special interests and talents?

**I've been involved with art ever since I've been a child. So I like to draw and paint. I am athletic and like to play sports. I really love boxing. I plan to take up boxing as a form of exercise to stay in shape. I'm ambidextrous, so that may be helpful in the sport. I write with my left hand and throw, bat, whatever with the right.
