PU#1: Heart Disease and High Blood Pressure: onset at 45, medication, condition remains (donor suspects his uncle does not follow recommended dietary changes)**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **MGM: Adult Onset Diabetes: onset at 35, diet controlled, condition managed.**

Respiratory: **MGF: Lung Cancer (smoked for 40+ years) Onset at 63, surgery and chemotherapy, reoccurrence and cause of death at 70.**

**My special interests and talents include sports and reading. I love sports, I wrestled from the age of 6 to 18 and plan to coach wrestling at the high school level.
