FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Genital/Reproductive: **PGF: Prostate Cancer, onset at 82, local radiation, spread to bones.**

Heart: **M: High Cholesterol, onset at 45, diet and medication, condition managed. F: Heart Disease, Heart Attack, onset at 54, stint and medication, condition remains, back in good shape; High Cholesterol, onset at 45, diet and medication, condition managed. MGF: Heart Attack, cause of death at 39, smoker for 25 years, overweight. MGM: High Blood Pressure, onset at 70, medication, condition managed. PGM: High Blood Pressure, onset in 40's, unknown treatment or outcome. PA#2: High Blood Pressure, recently diagnosed at 72, diet and medication.**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **PGF: Diabetes, adult onset in 50's, diet and medication, condition remained.**

Neurological: **M: Migraines, onset at 30, OTC meds, reoccurrence once a year. PA#1: Epilepsy (mild), onset at 15, medication, condition resolved in late 20's.**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **PGF: Bone Cancer, no treatment, cause of death at 84.**

Respiratory: **PGM: Emphysema (she smoked for 40 years), hospitalization, cause of death at 56.**

Sight/Sound/Smell: **Donor eyesight: R:20/15 L:20/20; Ear tubes, donor had a lot of ear infections as an infant, onset at 12-14 months, no more infections once tubes put in. PGM: Glaucoma, onset in 40's, unknown treatment, condition remained.**
