INTERVIEW NOTES: 3963

Donor 3963 has a sweet face and a wide grin with thin lips. He has clear tanned skin, bright blue eyes and long eyelashes. His small ears are hidden within his full, thick hair. One staff member commented on the resemblance of the donor to actor Adrian Brody, the lead in *The Pianist*. Donor 3963 could pass as a younger version of Adrian Brody with lighter and more refined features.

This donor was a bit shy and soft-spoken but unbelievably sweet and “happy-go-lucky”. The lab staff has mentioned, however that over time donor 3963 has opened up to become a polite and engaging young man. He bashfully told stories of his youth that exposed that he may not be as sweet and innocent as one may think. In fact, he was quite the dare-devil. This adventurous spirit has followed him into his young adulthood. The donor recently returned from a trip across Europe where he visited places such as Poland, Portugal, England and Amsterdam. He spent his time taking in the sights, smells and sounds, even finding some gigs as a DJ in Poland.

Currently the donor is attending college while working as an instructor’s assistant for a cooking school. He enjoys cooking, sighting his mother as an inspiration. Some of her favorite ingredients are, “bell peppers, swiss chard and tomatoes” the donor commented. He also said that his mother is a very sweet woman and likes schoolyard type arts and crafts such as “Shrinky Dinks” and painting on garden rocks. The donor’s father taught the donor responsibility, self-sustaining skills, paying bills and how to eat healthy. His older brother is described as a great musician and is currently on tour with his band. His younger brother is not as close to the donor as his other family members but is described as happy and healthy.

The donor has chosen to participate in our Identity-Release program, taking the initiative to request additional information and review the material before making his final decision.
