



## INTERVIEW NOTES: 4011

Donor 4011 is a well-dressed, very much put together guy. At our interview he wore a pressed dark blue button down shirt and khakis, brown loafers and a matching belt, looking casual and academic at the same time. He is clean shaven with a beautiful smooth, light skin tone. His hair is thick and unruly; a pile of dark gorgeous waves and curls. His hair color and skin tone are a striking contrast. His eyebrows are thick and dark over light brown eyes and his voice is deep and strong. I agree with the donor when he describes his nose as large and to me it matches his face perfectly.

Donor 4011 comes from a musical family. His mother raised him with a strong emphasis on music and the arts. She frequently took him to museums and taught him how to work with different artistic mediums. I asked him specifically about his musical talents and he shared with me that he helped composed music with his mother when he was young.

4011 is beginning Graduate school. He want to use his degree to help people which falls in line perfectly with the artistic/musical/spiritual person that I was sitting with. For fun he loves playing cards, like poker. He commented that *it uses every mental, emotional, strategic skill a person has. You are constantly forced to make decisions and choices. It is incredibly gratifying when you are right, and incredibly frustrating when you are wrong. You have to learn how not to let it affect you.* That he was cognizant of the fact that he was learning life skills from the game was remarkable and his enthusiasm was endearing.

At first, donor 4011 seemed aloof and slightly pretentious, but after we settled into our conversation he became more talkative. My lasting memory is his smile. He has beautiful full lips. His smile is sweet and boyish and disarming. 4011 is wonderful, a kind and charming person.
