FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Blood: **B: hepatitis-C, onset early twenties, used IV drugs very briefly (less than two months) and has tattoos.**
Cancer: **F: skin cancer, onset in mid-forties, successfully treated with excision and chemotherapy; MGF: lung cancer, onset in sixties, successfully treated with chemotherapy, smoked a pipe; PGF: diagnosed at 55, cause of death, avoided doctors and cancer had metastasized when diagnosed; MU: lung cancer, onset at 58, cause of death, smoker**
Gastro-intestinal: **PA: gall stones, onset in forties, successfully treated**
Genital/Reproductive: **M: ovarian cysts, onset early forties, successfully treated, only one cyst**
Heart: **MGF: aortic aneurysm at 80, cause of death; MU: heart attack in mid-fifties, recuperated and returned to work; M: high cholesterol, onset in mid-forties, successfully manages with medication, above average, but not dangerous; MGM: high cholesterol, onset in sixties, successfully manages with medication; PGM: high cholesterol, unsure of onset, successfully manages with medication**
Mental Health: Metabolic/Endocrine: **MA: adult onset diabetes, onset at 35, manages with medication, related to eating disorder in young adulthood**
Muscles/Bones/Joints: **MGM: osteoporosis, unsure of onset, takes vitamins and is very active**
Respiratory: **PC: asthma, childhood onset, successfully manages with inhaler**
Substance abuse: **MU: alcoholism, onset in early twenties, functioning, began while serving in Viet Nam**
