FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Cancer: **MGM: emphysema and lung cancer cause of death at age 75 (she was heavy smoker)**

Heart: **PGF: stroke in early 80's**

Mental Health: **M: depression, smoked marijuana and drank for a couple of years after her son and mother died within two years of each other, received therapy, anti-depressants, and inpatient drug treatment for a few months, has been clean and sober for two years**

Metabolic/Endocrine: **PGM: adult-onset diabetes, treats with medication, healthy at age 80**

Muscles/Bones/Joints: **M: scoliosis, treats with acupuncture**

Neurological: **B2: cerebral palsy with related seizures (cerebral palsy is a neurological condition caused by brain injury during pregnancy, birth, or infancy; it is not a hereditary condition; about 25% of children with cerebral palsy have epileptic seizures), seizures treated with medication that resulted in liver failure, causing death at age 22**

Substance abuse: **MGM: alcoholism**
