Heart: **PGF: Heart Failure, died at 77; MGM: High Blood Pressure, onset at 65 treated with medication and currently stable**  
Metabolic/Endocrine: **PGF: Adult Onset Diabetes, diagnosed at 75, treated with diet and exercise, contributed to death**  
Muscles/Bones/Joints: **PGM: Bone Cancer, diagnosed at 65, cause of death at 66**  
Respiratory: **S: Asthma, onset at 8, treated with inhaler, does not impede regular exercise**  
Sight/Sound/Smell: **D: Right 20/20, Left 20/20; MGM: Anosmia, onset at 18, no treatment, condition is mild, she can smell strong scents**  
Substance abuse: **M: Drug Abuse, onset at 25, treated unsuccessfully with multiple drug treatment rehabilitation programs. The donor describes his mother's health as "good".**
