Interview Notes

Donor 4117 is a young, clean-cut guy. He has strong, broad shoulders and tanned skin. His face is square-shaped, his hair trimmed into a handsome crew cut and he has beautiful eyes with long eyelashes and full lips. He was casually dressed in a T-shirt, dark blue jeans and fashionable high-tops with black laces. Donor 4117 talked about his striking resemblance to Prince Henry and I agreed. He also told me that his father is a spitting image of the actor Harrison Ford.

The donor lives at home with his parents and sister. He expressed a desire to find a place on his own but said that he is happy at home with his family and he can't beat the price. He remarked that although his family members claim to be unique, they are all more similar than they like to admit. This is especially true with the donor and his sister; they have a similar sense of humor and enjoy each others company.

The donor is currently pursuing his undergraduate degree. He is unsure of his area of focus thus far, but enjoys the variety of different classes. He did divulge a dream of going to school to study brewery (beer making). He hopes to work for a brewery in the near future and open his own brewery in the future. He also hopes to travel to Greece and Southern Europe in the near future as well. He recently went to Italy and absolutely fell in love with the history, loosing himself in the ruins and museums.

The donor is a passionate musician. He enjoys playing and writing music. He currently plays in two bands, alternating between plying the bass and guitar. He really enjoys listening to punk and hardcore music, and listed some of his favorite bands as Black Flag and Paint in Black.

Donor 4117 is a kind and thoughtful person. He was a bit shy and uneasy at first but warmed up throughout the interview. He admitted that he tends to take time to warm up to a new group of people. However, I would say that he has more refined and discrete social skills, providing a good ear for listening.
