### FAMILY MEDICAL HISTORY

Gastro-intestinal: **PGM: Cirrhosis, onset at 75, no treatment, contributed to death at 80. MC#1: Crohn's disease, onset at 15, medication, stabilized but ongoing.**  
Heart: **F: High Blood Pressure: onset at 38, medication, condition managed. MGF: High Blood Pressure: onset in 60's, medication, condition managed.**  
Neurological: **D, M, MA 1, 2, 3, MU1: Migraines, onset in childhood, OTC meds, managed. MGM: Migraines, onset in 20s, OTC meds, managed. MGM: Multiple Sclerosis, onset at 30, medication, resulted in death at 71.**  
Respiratory: **MGM, MA#1, MA#2, MA#3: Hay fever, onset in childhood, managed with OTC meds. MU: Asthma, onset in childhood, medication, resolved. MGF: Emphysema, onset in 70's, oxygen and medication, was a smoker for most of life, steady decline.**  
Sight/Sound/Smell: **D: Chronic Ear Infections: onset at 4, temporary hearing tubes, mild reduction in hearing due to scarring; Eyesight R: 20/200 L:20/200**  
Skin: **PGF: Skin Cancer, onset in 50's, surgery, resolved**  
Substance Abuse: **PGM: Alcoholism, onset at 30, was in AA for more than 40 years, developed cirrhosis.**  
Urinary: **F: Kidney Stones, onset at 33, medication and surgery, infrequent reoccurrences.**  
Cancer (see above): **PGF: Skin Cancer. PGM: Liver Cancer, onset at 75, treated with radiofrequency ablation**
