## INTERVIEW NOTES: 2992

Donor 2992 is what I would describe as a *traditionally* handsome guy with a square –to-oval face, very symmetrical features, beautifully-shaped full lips, and smooth skin.

He served in the U.S. Army Reserves for six years, only one of which involved active duty. He began working toward an airplane pilot's license, but has not yet completed the process.
